Eleanor Westbrook : One Mouth, Many Voices

Ellie Westbrook is an interdisciplinary performer working at the intersection of opera, physical theatre, clowning, and experimental music. She is artistic director of her Hastings-based theatre company TUFT, putting on performances in castles and caves and currently developing a multidisciplinary adaptation of Titus Andronicus.

She has performed across the UK and internationally, including the Southbank Centre, La Mama (New York), Waste Paper Opera Company, Kneehigh Theatre and Belarus Free Theatre.

Her original performance works have featured at Eavesdropping Festival, Soho Theatre's Fool's Moon, and the De La Warr Pavilion, and she recently completed a Music Theatre tour with composer-performers James Oldham and Natacha Diels.

Ellie studied devising & performance at LISPA (now Arthaus Berlin) and a vocal studies Masters at Trinity Laban Conservatoire, and trained with the Belarus Free Theatre.
